Dear Ms. Osgood:

Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:46, N.J.A.C. 6A:14-4.1 et. seq. and N.J.A.C. 6A:23, please be advised that effective July 1, 2026, Limitless School is preliminarily approved by the New Jersey Department of Education, for the 2026-2027 and 2027-28 school years, at the address indicated above. Please note that if, at some future time, the school plans to move to another location, prior written approval from the county office of education is required.

In accordance with N.J.A.C. 6A:23-4.3(c), Limitless School must provide documentation that the school has a minimum average daily enrollment of 24 public school placement pupils by the end of the second school year (2027-28). When a receiving school meets this minimum average daily enrollment of 24 public school placement pupils by the end of the second school year, the school shall receive new school approval. A school not meeting the minimum average daily enrollment of 24 public school placement pupils by the end of the second school year shall have its preliminary approval status revoked and shall no longer be considered an approved private school for the disabled. If the school attains the minimum average daily enrollment of 24 public school placement pupils but falls below that amount in a subsequent school year, the school must attain the minimum average daily enrollment of 24 public school placement pupils by the end of the third year after the year in question, or school approval shall be rescinded.

New Jersey Department of Education staff will conduct on-site visits during the period of preliminary approval. If it is verified that the school is in compliance with the applicable regulations, the school shall receive notice of new school approval status prior to school year 2028-29. The school will then enter the regular monitoring cycle, which is conducted minimally, once every six years.

Based upon the application submitted by your school, preliminary approval is granted to operate special class programs for the following:

The tentative tuition rates for the school year 2026-2027 are as follows:

The tentative tuition rates for school year 2027-28 are as follows:

The above tuition rates represent the tentative per diem rate that may be charged to the local school districts. The total ten-month rate and the extended rate, if applicable, are based on the number of enrolled days in each program times the per diem rate.

The tuition for a pupil enrolled in a preschool program (10 hours per week), a half-day program, or enrolled in a full-day program on a shared time basis, shall be one-half of the full-day program rate. The actual tuition rates charged to the local school district will be determined by the year-end audited financial statements and certified by the Commissioner of Education.
